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### PC 148.6 COMPLAINT ADVISEMENT

You have the right to make a complaint against a police officer for any improper police conduct. We follow California law which requires law enforcement agencies to have a procedure to investigate citizen's complaints. You have a right to have a written description of this procedure. This agency may find after investigation that there is not enough evidence to warrant action on your complaint; even if that is the case, you have the right to make the complaint and have it investigated if you believe an officer behaved improperly. Citizen complaints and any reports or findings relating to complaints must be retained by this agency for at least five years. It is against the law to make a complaint that you know to be false. If you make a complaint against an officer knowing that it is false, you can be prosecuted for violation of California Penal Code Section 148.6, a misdemeanor.
