Team structure and duties are discussed as we identify subject types, risk assessment, and suicidal factors. Various individual and group exercises are employed in this class to allow the student to apply newly acquired knowledge and training. A full scale, daylong practical training incident on the final day of class allows an assessment of each student's capabilities in action, utilizing various team roles and functions. From historical examinations of slavery, to the use of modern technology and social media, this course is designed to give investigators, victim services providers, and other practitioners a robust understanding of why, and how, exploitation occurs. This course is designed for anyone involved in the response to trafficking who desires a deeper knowledge of the challenges involved, how we can all better support victims of trafficking, and successfully prosecute traffickers.

The object of this class is to provide basic awareness, articulate the nexus between trafficking and displaced persons, update skills, gain knowledge and to maintain competency as a front-line first identifier combating modern day slavery.

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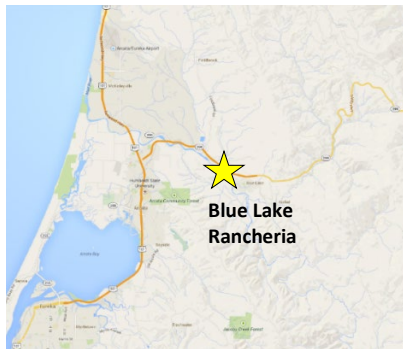
Terrorism/Homeland Security Specialist Certification

DIRECTIONS: The Blue Lake Rancheria RTIC is located in Humboldt County, California on State Route 299 east. Take the Blue Lake Exit (Exit 5) onto Blue Lake Blvd. Turn right at the round-about and follow Chartin Road straight into the Blue Lake Rancheria.

Sapphire Palace Event Center: 777 Casino Way.

~Enter main entrance of Blue Lake Rancheria and stay to the right.

~Use casino general parking area.

~After you go through the main casino door, go left.

~The entrance to the Sapphire Palace is to the right of the Redwood Rewards Club.

Claudia Brundin Health Center: 5 Hlow Lane.

~Enter main entrance of Blue Lake Rancheria and stay to the right

~follow Chartin Road and turn right into Casino Way.

~Take Casino Way past the Blue Lake Casino and Hotel and turn right, following signs for the health center.

Tribal Government Office: 1 Aiyekwee Loop.

~Enter main entrance Blue Lake Rancheria.

~Take Batwot Drive past gas station and continue through to Rancheria Road.

~Turn right at Rancheria Road through the open chain link gate.

~Straight ahead to the Tribal Gov't Office is on the right, near fire department (blue metal building). ~Entrance on north side of building where electric car chargers are.
